

# Button-Covered Star

## Ages 3 and Up

You may want to leave this one out all year long! This one is so easy that you'll want to make a whole bunch. Get a good supply of buttons and have fun!



### Materials:

Foam Core – check at your local framers for free scraps!

White Buttons – lots and lots

White Glue

Glitter

3/8" Ribbon

X-Acto Knife

Paper Plate

### Directions:

1. Trace a star on a piece of foam core. You can use the star pattern I've provided or make your own.
2. Working on a cutting mat, cut out star with an x-acto knife.
3. Poke a hole through one of the points and thread a piece of ribbon through the hole. You can use a bamboo skewer or a pencil.
4. Place the star on a paper plate. Have your child squeeze a generous amount of glue on the star and place as many buttons as possible on the star. Younger artists won't be able to fit as many buttons on their star, but it will still be adorable!
5. Sprinkle with glitter and allow to dry.
