

Dots and Ink Pictures

Ages 5 and Up



I've already mentioned this idea in the "3-in-1 Picture," but I have to revisit this project because I found the BEST polka dot painters. These were a big hit with my summer art program, and I'm sure your kids will love them too. These vibrant colors combined with the striking black ink will result in some great artwork that you can create at your kitchen table.

Don't be afraid of India Ink. It wipes up easily and washes out of clothes. With supervision, your kids can use this ink without any problems.

Materials:

- Crafty Dab brand KIDS PAINT (scented!)
- Small bottle of India Ink or Sumi Ink
- A sharpened stick from your yard
- Sturdy paper or poster board



Instructions:

1. Spread out newspaper on a work surface, preferably in your kitchen.
2. Create a picture as desired with the dot painters. Anything goes!
3. Add black accents to the picture with the ink. Dip the sharpened stick in the pot of ink and add doodles to the picture. Repeat this process until satisfied with the picture. Tip: Keep the ink bottle AWAY from the edge of the table. ☺
4. Allow to dry.
