

Easy Mother's Day Booklet Ages 4 and Up



I love written recordings of what young children are thinking. It's like time in a bottle. See if you can get someone (dad, babysitter, grandma, etc.) to sit down with your child and fill in the answers to these questions. Have some colored pencils or thin markers handy so that your child can add his own illustrations. This will be your favorite Mother's Day gift, guaranteed!

Materials:

Large Shipping Tags (4³/₄" x 2 ³/₈")
Avery Shipping Labels #8163 (2" x 4")
10" piece of Wide Ribbon or scrap fabric
Colored Pencils or Thin Markers

Directions:

1. Print out the labels using the PDF provided.
2. Stick labels on to large shipping tags.
3. Sit down with your child, especially if he is a non reader, and help him fill in his answers. The adult will write out the words, and your child will make the illustrations.
4. Stack all of the tags together and tie together with a pretty piece of ribbon or fabric scrap.
