

# Egg Decorating I

## Ages 5 and Up

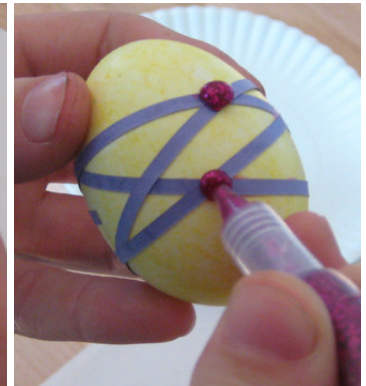
### Paper Flowers:

All you need for this egg is two flower paper punches, some sequins, a green quilling strip, glue stick, white glue, and a pair of scissors. Cut the quilling strip lengthwise into 3 or 4 inch pieces. Punch out a few flowers from medium-weight paper. Apply glue stick to the strips and press on to the egg. Tweezers come in handy here. Do the same for the flowers. Apply small dots of white glue in the flower centers and press on the sequins. Optional: Add a seed bead to the center of each sequin.



### Quilling Strip Design:

You will need a 24" quilling strip, glue stick, and glitter glue. Apply glue stick to the back of the entire length of the quilling strip. Wrap the strip around the egg so it the strip lays flat on the surface of the egg. Let the strip tell you where it wants to go. Apply a small dot of glitter glue where the strip intersects.



**Sequined Egg:** You will need sequins, white glue, tweezers, and seed beads. Apply small dots of glue on the surface of the egg. Press sequins on the glue dots. Place a seed bead in the center of each sequin. I recommend decorating half of the egg, allowing the glue to dry, then decorating the rest.



**Polka Dot Egg:** You will need Polka Dot Painters and glitter. Decorate the surface of the egg with paint dots as desired. Shake on glitter and allow to dry.
