

Picture Stand

Ages 4 and Up

This is the perfect desk accessory!



Materials:

- (3) Cardboard Coasters – available in the Artsy Mommy online store
- (2) Digital Photos – printed out on card stock and trimmed
- Mod Podge and Brush
- Mixed Buttons – I found mine at www.enasco.com
- White Glue
- Masking Tape or Paper Tape

Directions:

1. Using a simple photo editing program, crop and resize two digital pictures of your child to roughly 2.5” square. Print them out onto a sheet of card stock and cut them out.
2. With a paint brush, apply a layer of Mod Podge to the surface of one of the coasters. Place one of the pictures on the coaster (it doesn’t have to be straight) and apply another layer of Mod Podge over the picture. Do the same for the other coaster.
3. Squeeze a line of white glue around the outside of one of the pictures and place buttons around it. Do the same for the other one. Allow to dry for a few hours or overnight.
4. Rotate the two coasters to that the pictures are head-to-head then flip them over. Join them with a piece of tape. Take the third coaster and attach it with another piece of tape. Bring the two outer edges together (to make a triangle) and join them with a piece of tape on the inside.
