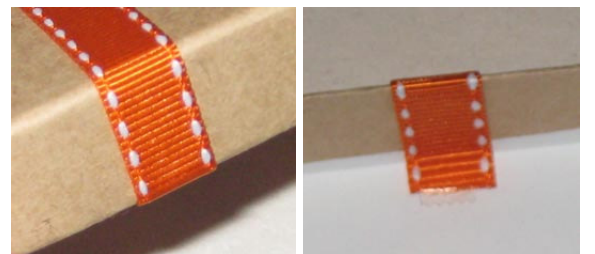


Ribbon-Covered Box

Ages 5 and Up

This is a great way to spruce up an old gift box **and** use up your scraps of ribbon. When doing this with children, don't worry about ribbon placement. Crooked ribbon looks just as good as straight!



Materials:

Lidded Gift Box
Double-Sided Tape
Ribbon Remnants

Directions:

1. Cut your ribbon into lengths 2 inches longer than the dimension of your box lid.
2. Cut a piece of tape the length of your ribbon. If your ribbon is narrower than the tape then you can cut the tape down the center.
3. Place the tape on the back of the ribbon and remove the backing paper.
4. Place on the box lid. Wrap the ribbon around the sides and on to the inside of the lid. Press firmly.
5. Add more ribbon in a criss-cross pattern. Straight placement is not necessary.
6. Once covered as desired, replace the box lid.
