

Valentine Candy Box

Ages 6 and Up

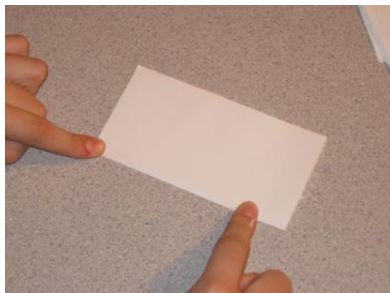
This origami paper box is the perfect container for your Valentine treats!

Materials:

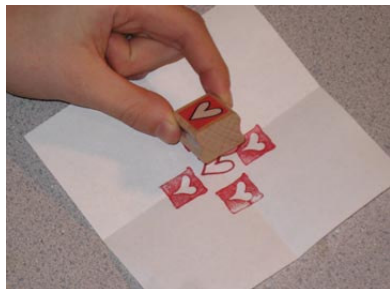
Printer Paper: White (5.5" square)
Red (5.25" square)
Rubber Stamps and Ink Pad



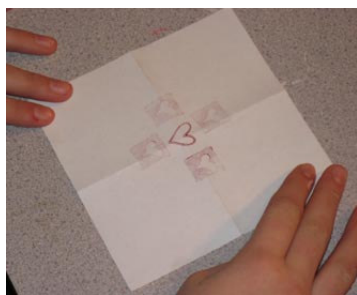
Directions:



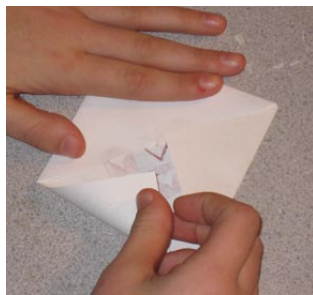
1. Fold a piece of white paper in half. Open it up, and fold the paper in half the other way.



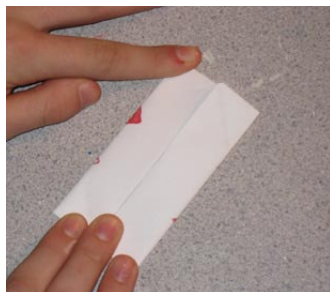
2. Add rubber stamps to the center of the paper.



3. Turn the paper over.



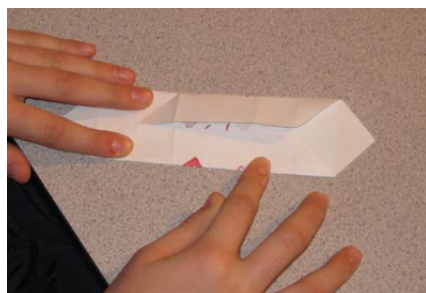
4. Fold each corner into the center. It will look like an envelope when finished.



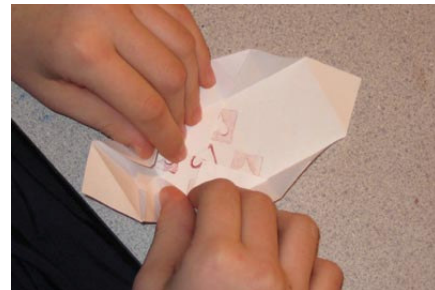
5. Fold opposite sides into the center. Check to make sure all of your sides and seam are all parallel. Open the two sides and do the same for the other two remaining sides.



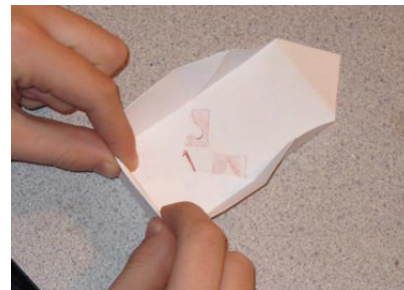
6. Open the two sides, then pull apart two opposite corners all the way.



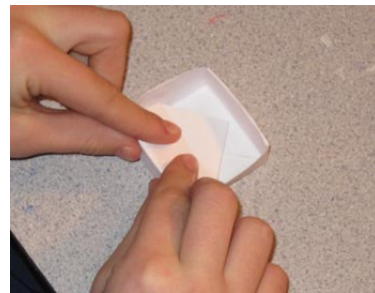
7. Fold down top and bottom sides so that they meet in the center again. Crease the folds all the way out to the points.



8. Stand up the sides. With your thumbs, push in the corners. This should cause the point to stand up.



9. Fold the point down into the box. You won't be making any new folds. Use the creases that are already there as a guide.



10. Do the same for the other side.



11. Repeat all of the steps for the bottom (show here in red). The bottom slides inside the lid as shown. It should be a tight fit.
